The A82 Borlum Bridge crosses the River Coiltie at Lewiston, south of Drumnadrochit. The bridge was built in 1933 and is a single-span concrete structure.

Impressed Current Cathodic Protection had been installed to A82 Borlum Bridge in Drumnadrochit. The existing control equipment had failed and required replacing.

BearScotland engaged CCSL to undertake the replacement of the existing failed equipment; the new control system was developed by Force Technology/CPI in conjunction with CCSL and was energised in June 2015.

CCSL will continue to undertake the performance monitoring remotely on behalf of BearScotland.



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
